Reparation Officer

Post title: Reparation Officer (part-time), as part of Froglife's Peterborough Environment Enrichment Project (PEEP).

Duration of post: 3rd September 2010 – 31st March 2011

Number of hours a week: 22.5 hours per week – Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays (with Friday evening sessions fortnightly).

SALARY: £18,000 pa pro rata (£11,570 pa). Own transport required (mileage covered).

Overview description of the post:

A role has opened up within Froglife's education team to work with vulnerable young people as part of Froglife's Peterborough Environment Enrichment Project (PEEP).

PEEP delivers practical conservation projects to young offenders, helping develop their basic skills whilst giving something back to the local community (while helping amphibian and reptiles in the process). Activities that young people undertake through the project have included: nature reserve make-overs, wildlife gardening, pond-digging sessions and wildlife carpentry. We are seeking applications for the role of Reparation Officer, for a seven-month contract (September 2010 to March 2011). Based in Peterborough, the post-holder will coordinate and lead wildlife conservation activities for young offenders passed through to Froglife from the Peterborough Youth Offending Service.

This is a unique opportunity to take a leading role in a cutting-edge project, within an up-and-coming charity commended for its inclusive attitude to wildlife conservation. The project was last month awarded a Green Award by the Peterborough Evening Telegraph.
