



# Limoncello

## CASE STUDY

### BACKGROUND

Limoncello (Cambridge) Ltd is an Italian restaurant and deli located in Cambridge. The business was exploring options to reduce operational costs and had identified the installation of a solar PV system to reduce their electricity costs as a potential option.

Limoncello contacted the ENE Grant Scheme team to see if their proposed 4.18kWp solar PV project was eligible for grant funding and were subsequently awarded a grant of £1,262 towards project costs.

The solar PV system will deliver estimated annual cost savings of around £500 and help to reduce Limoncello's carbon footprint by 1.6 tonnes.
